

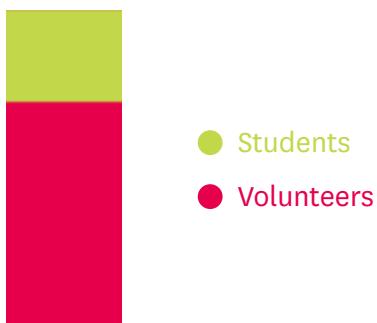


YES 2016: Call for Hamburg Intern

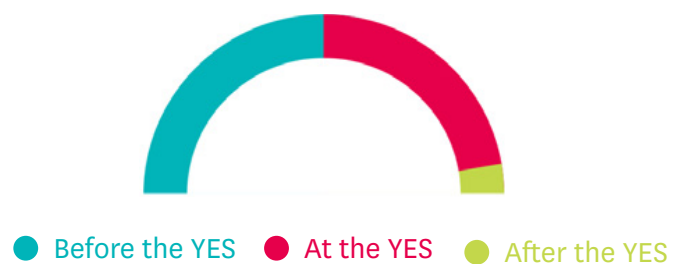
Your role in one sentence

YES 2016

The Young Europeans' Seminar (YES) is the **biggest YFU event**, which gathers every year intra-European YFU students at the end of their exchange program. More than 500 exchange students and more than 100 volunteers from participate in the YES and make each YES unique.

The YES is the ideal meeting space where to end the exchange experience before returning home, where to develop awareness of European and global issues, and where to learn new things in a truly intercultural environment. The YES combines fun and learning (both for the students and for the volunteers) and uses non-formal education methods to allow participants to explore a relevant theme, different every year.

The topic of the YES 2016 is “**Young Innovators Changing Our World**”. Young people are the catalyst of innovation in many fields; with their creative and critical thinking, they have the

power to trigger positive changes within their communities and beyond.

The topic of the YES 2016 will be tackled from different angles: innovations for a more sustainable and greener world; new forms of global citizenship with young people on the frontline of digital activism; and youth initiatives that reshape intercultural dialog and understanding in our increasingly diverse societies. We have a message to pass on to all YES participants: you are not only the future of our society, you have a key role to play today. **The Youth Century is now!**

The YES 2016 will be held in Werbellinsee (Germany) from **27th June to 1st July**. It is organized by EEE-YFU together with YFU Denmark and YFU Switzerland, with the in-country support of YFU Germany.



Your role

What do you gain?

Participating at the YES as an intern is a truly rewarding experience. There is so much you can gain:

- Possibility to share your volunteer experience and get to know a lot of new people
- Increasing skills in managing a project, working in a multi-cultural team, and in organising a big event
- Experience of working on an international level
- Living the YFU spirit
- Opportunity to be a part of the biggest YFU event in Europe and have a great time

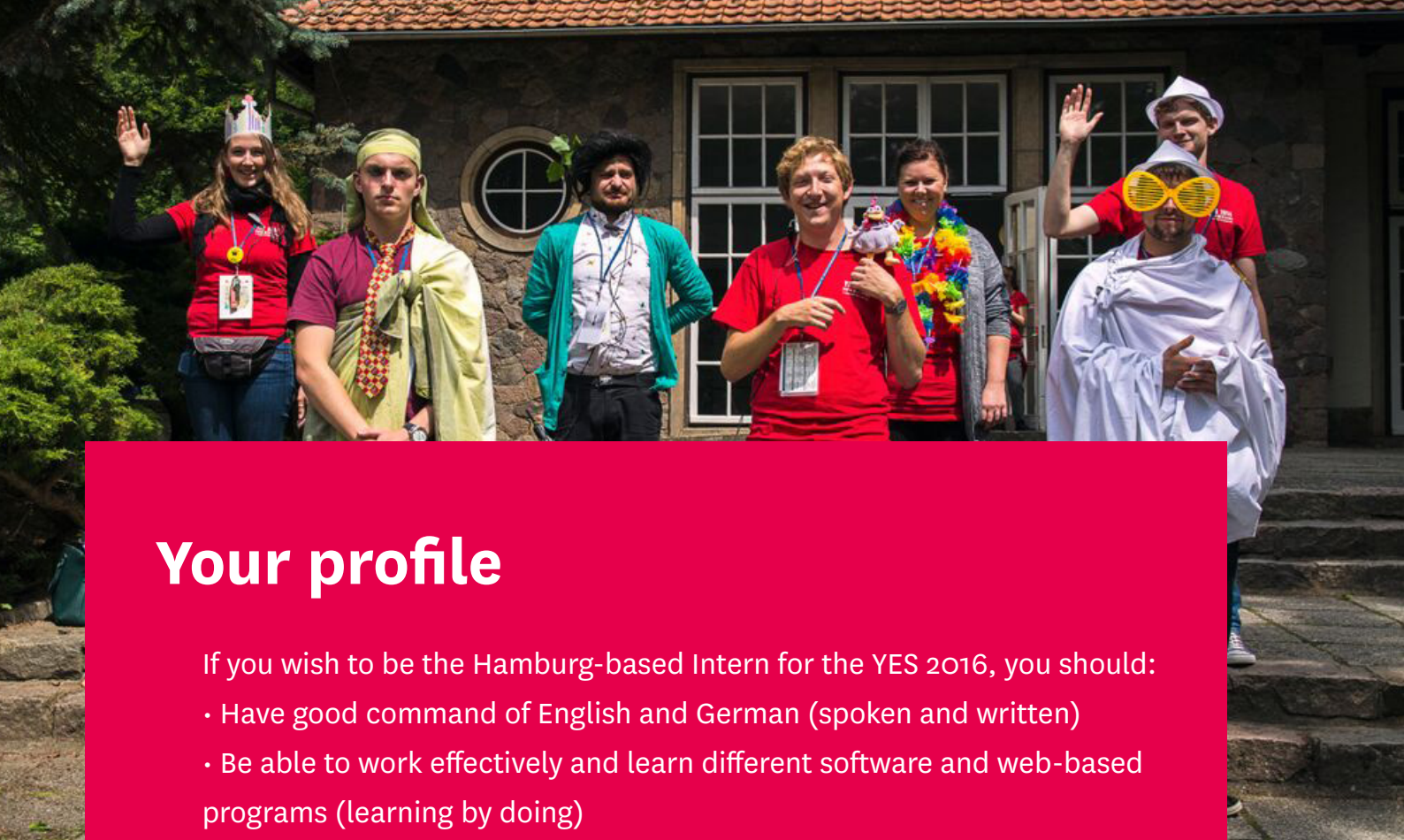
You will start your internship at the beginning of June 2015 (~June 6th) and finish at the beginning of July 2015 (~July 6th). You will be based in YFU Germany office in Hamburg.

Your international travel expenses will be reimbursed upon receipt. In addition, we will provide a small monthly stipend to help you cover your costs. You are responsible for having a valid insurance and visa (if needed).

As the YES Intern, you will be responsible for providing administrative, logistic, and management support for the YES 2016 Organising team. One of your main tasks will be ordering, purchasing and sorting all necessary materials prior to the YES 2016. You will assist in handling logistical matters, such as preparing all participants' name tags, signs, and the logo panel.

In the days before the event, you will supporting the YES 2016 travel team by preparing arrival, departure and other travel-related information for students and volunteers.

At the YES itself, you will assist the Content and the Logistic Team Leaders in a variety of tasks – be ready for improvisation, and hard work! In the days after the YES, you will take care of repacking and stocking different materials.



Your profile

If you wish to be the Hamburg-based Intern for the YES 2016, you should:

- Have good command of English and German (spoken and written)
- Be able to work effectively and learn different software and web-based programs (learning by doing)
- Have previous YES experience (desirable) or experience in working in the organisation of events
- Have high level of motivation, responsibility and dedication to the objectives of the YES 2016
- Be able to work independently and make reasoned decisions as well as ability to keep deadlines
- Have quick comprehension of new concepts and be a team player
- Have good time management and organizational skills, a willingness to learn and the ability to work under pressure
- Be enrolled in a related University Program, such as Management, Communications, or other (preferential, but not compulsory)
